

Continue your higher education.



In 1950, roughly **431,000** people earned Bachelor's Degrees. **Today**, roughly **1,895,000** people earned Bachelor's Degrees.




## GENERAL LIFE ADVICE In the end, it's not the years in your life that count. It's the life in your years.


